

INSTALLING SAFE EXAM BROWSER (SEB) FOR MAC

SEB is a web browser that prevents users from opening new tabs on their computers or visiting new web pages during online exams, rather than those relevant to the exam. To be able to take the English Proficiency Exam (EPE), you must install SEB on the computer that you will use to take the exam. Please follow the steps below to complete the set-up of SEB:

1. Type “safe exam browser mac” into your search engine and go to safexambrowser.org.



2. Download the version for macOS.

3. Drag the Safe Exam Browser icon into the Applications file in the window that will appear.

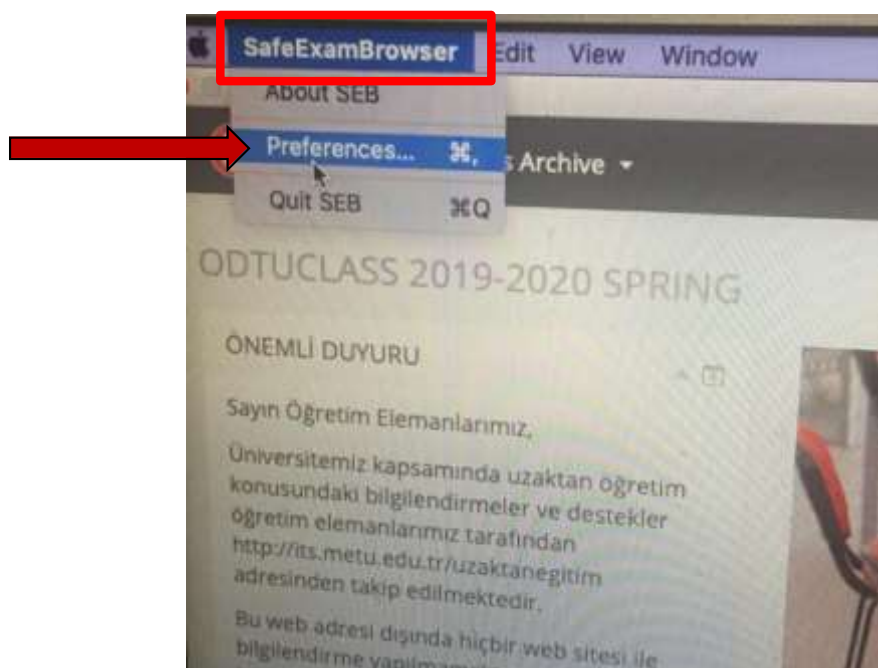


4. Open the Safe Exam Browser app, which is located in the Applications file.

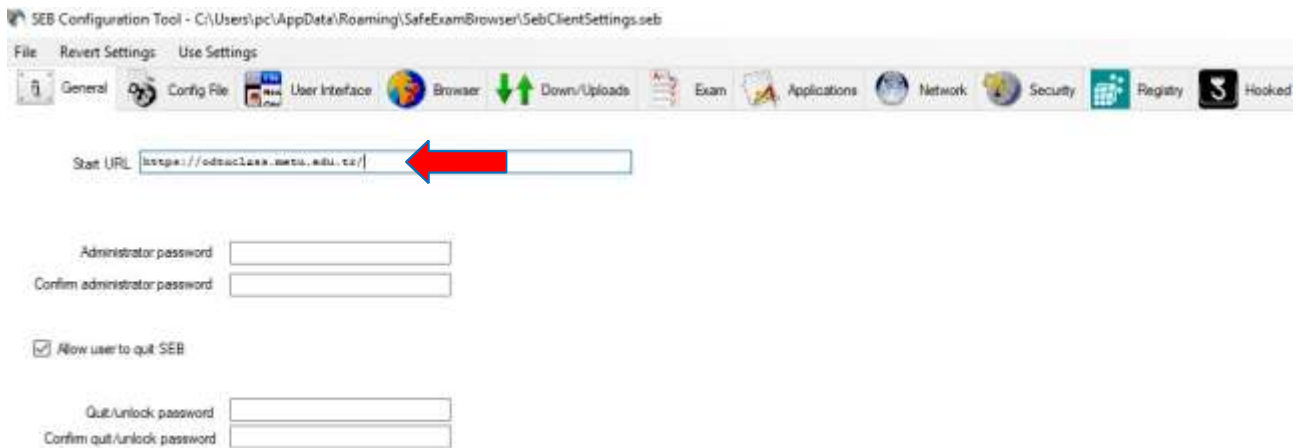


5. When the app is open on the screen, click SafeExamBrowser next to the Apple logo at the top and select "Preferences" from the drop-down menu.

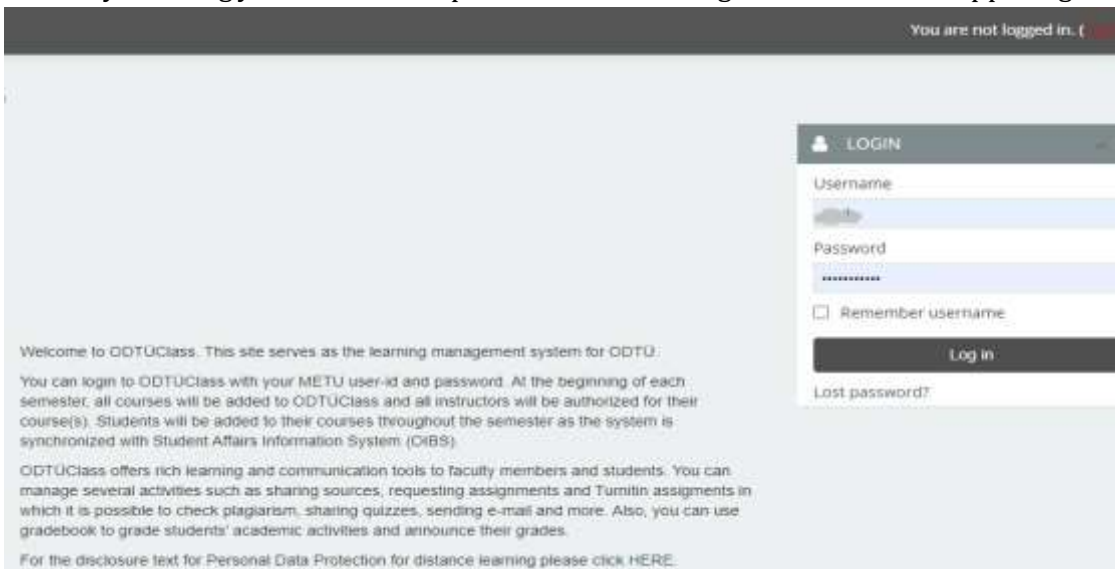
IMPORTANT NOTE: You may not be able see the text "SafeExamBrowser" in full screen mode.



6. Check the exam announcement on the [METU NCC SFL](#) web page for the “**Start URL**” address and type it into the section in the small window that will appear and click the “Restart SEB” button. Then, click the “Apply” button in the small window that will appear.



7. Your SEB installation is now complete. When you need to use the SEB, open the application and log in by entering your user ID and password into the “log in” section in the upper right corner.



8. When the exam is over, click the quit button in the lower right corner of the window to exit SEB.
