

(METU NCC) Frequently Asked Questions

<p>What are the parts of the exam and their weightings?</p>	<p>The exam comprises three parts: Reading, Vocabulary and Writing.</p> <p>The weighting of these parts are as follows: Reading: 60 points, Vocabulary: 10 points and Writing: 30 points.</p>
<p>How much time is allocated for each part?</p>	<p>You will have 60 minutes for the Reading part, 10 minutes for the Vocabulary part, and 30 minutes for the Writing part.</p> <p>These three parts will be completed as three separate quizzes. Once you complete one part, you can start with the next one. It should be noted that if you finish a part early, the time remaining from that part will not be added to the following parts.</p>
<p>How do we do the Writing part of the exam?</p>	<p>You will complete the writing part by <u>typing</u> your response in the allocated space.</p>
<p>Is there a document where I can get information about the content of the exam and see sample questions?</p>	<p>Yes. You can reach the <i>METU-SFL English Proficiency Exam: A Guide for Test Takers</i> document using the link below:</p> <p>https://epe.metu.edu.tr/EpeKitapcigi.pdf</p>
<p>Where can I get information about the exam sessions?</p>	<p>Throughout the exam, you will be monitored by proctors through the video conferencing program <i>Cisco-Webex</i>. The link for the <i>Cisco-Webex</i> session you will need for the exam will be sent to you via email at least one day prior to the exam.</p>
<p>When and how will I learn my exam results?</p>	<p>The exam results will be announced on the date stated on the academic calendar. You can access your results through the related link below:</p> <p>http://epe.metu.edu.tr</p>

<p>Can I take the exam on my Mac computer, mobile phone, or tablet?</p>	<p>You can take the exam on your Mac computer. However, the exam cannot be taken on a mobile phone or a tablet as they are not compatible with the exam interface.</p>
<p>Will I be able to ask questions to the proctors during the exam?</p>	<p>You can ask questions to the proctors via Webex chat box <u>provided your questions are not related to the content of the exam.</u></p>
